Competitions

- **Saturday** is Men's competition day with generally 230 to 260 members and visitors playing, Times are available for Ladies between 7:30 to 8:30 and approx 10:44 to 11:05. A Grade Juniors play 18 holes with B & C Grade playing 9 holes. Times available for juniors are from approximately 6:30 am.
- **Sundays** is a mixed/medley day and are a great social day with the very popular Jack & Jill days attracting many visitors.
- **Monday** Mixed Veterans (aged 55 and over) play a 9 hole competition and meet in the clubhouse around 10:30 am. Another popular competition is the 9 hole chook run played each working day except Thursday. They meet in the clubhouse and tee off around 12:30.
- **Tuesday** Ladies play a 9 hole competition incorporating beginners. An 18 hole competition is played once a month from April to August. Medley 18 hole single stableford is held here when ever the MNC Vets are not scheduled. You can always check on the Website.
- **Wednesday** is Ladies day with generally 100 to 120 Ladies playing.
- **Thursday** is Men's competition day with 220 to 240 members and visitors playing
- **Friday** Proshop Challenge & Ladybird Challenge, a men's and ladies single stableford event held once a month.

Competition Description

Most competition entry fee is \$13.00 (including GST and ball competition) – payable at the Proshop at least 20 minutes prior to your tee time.

Competition Vouchers

Vouchers won during competitions can be deposited directly on to your club account, this can be used over the bar at the Coffs Harbour Golf Club. They also can be redeemed at the Proshop, Lily's Café & Function Centre or for golf lessons with Peter Pearce.

Electric Carts

The Coffs Harbour Golf Club has electric carts for hire and as a member you will receive a discount rate.

Members discounts

Members discounts apply across the bar at the Coffs Harbour Golf Club, a membership card must be presented. Money can be deposited onto your membership cards to pay for your purchase over the bar. Please see the administration department for more details.

Social golf is free to our members but before commencing social play you are required to report to the Proshop to swipe your card for insurance purposes.

Practice Greens/Driving Range
